

Kamari is inhabited all year round by 1400 permanent residents, it has a pharmacy, a small surgery, two cinemas, one of which is outdoors, while on the walkway next to the sea, visitors can enjoy a stroll, wander round the various shops, relax in the cafeterias overlooking the sea, enjoy a drink at the bars, taste traditional Santorini dishes in the picturesque tavernas and try international cuisine at the restaurants in the area.

Sights in the area are: **Ancient Thira** situated on the hill of Mesa Vouno 369 metres above sea level, which was founded in the 9th century BC by Dorian tribes, the small chapel of

, a church built by the Byzantine emperor Alexios I Komninos at the end of the 11th century, the Wine Museum and others.

Other activities you can try are scuba-diving in the enchanting sea around Santorini, horse-riding, mountaineering, paragliding, and for lovers of hiking and nature, you can explore the paths on the hill of Mesa Vouno.
